## CITY OF WALKER COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

August 12, 2024 6:00 PM

The regular meeting of the Walker Mayor and City Council was held at Walker City Hall—13600 Aydell Lane on Monday, August 12, 2024 at 6:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jimmy Watson, followed by prayer led by Councilman Gary Griffin. Municipal Clerk, Tammy Payton, commenced with the roll call of the council members.

The following council members were present: David Clark, Eric Cook, Gary Griffin, and Scarlett Milton-Major. Councilman Richard Wales was absent.

Mayor Watson called for a motion to adopt/approve the minutes of the July 8, 2024 council meeting. There were no comments or objections.

The City of Walker finance director, Mike Cotton, reviewed the June 2024 finance report before the council. He reported sales tax increased by 2% and gas revenue decreased by 3%.

## Resolution to Adopt the City of Walker 2024 Millage

The new millage rate adjusted from 2.23 mills to 1.83 mills after the reassessment of the taxable value amount of \$79,844,960. This will yield a projected revenue amount of \$146,116.28. Two-thousand twenty-four (2024) is a reassessment year. The previous reassessment was in 2020.

Upon a motion made by Ms. Major, seconded by Mr. Griffin, the <u>Resolution to Adopt the</u> <u>City of Walker 2024 Millage</u> was approved as presented.

- ♦ Mayor Watson announced the retirement of Mr. Tommy Martinez of Senator John Kennedy's office. Mr. Martinez remarked that this city is one of the most professionally managed governments he has ever seen.
- ♦ Mary Maiden announced that Club Outreach will have a fundraiser on Thursday, August 15<sup>th</sup>. The proceeds will be used toward building improvements.
