Livingston Parish OHSEP, in partnership with the Stephenson Disaster Management Institute (SDMI) at LSU, is leading the process to update the plan. The Livingston Parish Hazard Mitigation Plan describes the **naturally** occurring risks to the region and outlines strategies to reduce these risks to save lives, reduce property damage, and lessen the impact of future disasters. This plan is updated through a thorough planning and review process every five years.
