Mr. Jamie Etheridge updated the council on the AMI – Water Meter System. The company UMS had been selected for the turn key operation which includes all water meters being change out to an AMI system (a remote read system) and billing software integration. Anticipated completion by June 2019.

Mr. Jamie Etheridge updated the council on bridge projects throughout the City, indicating the Keith Street bridge project was still pending due to the wetlands permit. Once the permit is received then RFP's will go out. The Travis Street bridge project is anticipated to start by the end of the second quarter of 2019. Elm and Brown Street bridges are part of the FEMA 2016 flood repair. FEMA has obligated the funds and the RFQ has been issued. Once the engineering firm has been selected, design will start and take approximately 60 days. Once the design is complete, it will go out for bid. Anticipated start date will be early second quarter of 2019.
