Proclamation of Parish-wide Stay at Home Order Extension of Emergency Provisions

WHEREAS, in the days since the last Proclamation was issued on 22 March 2020, the COVID-19 outbreak in Louisiana has expanded significantly, and


WHEREAS, on 2 April 2020, Louisiana Governor John Bel Edwards issued Proclamation Number 41 JBE 2020, extending his previously proclaimed emergency provisions to 30 April 2020 for the Stay at Home Order, school closures, non-essential business closure to the public, etc., and

WHEREAS, these extension measures are being enacted to slow the spread of this virus and protect the citizens of Livingston Parish, Louisiana as a whole and surrounding areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Layton Ricks, Livingston Parish President, do hereby proclaim the following:

- A) Fully support and emulate the provisions set forth by Governor Edwards in Proclamation Number 41 JBE 2020 for Livingston Parish government, citizens and businesses.
- B) Extend the closure of all Livingston Parish Government/Council offices to 30 April 2020.
- C) Encourage all residents to limit their exposure to this virus through adhering to the Stay at Home order, maintaining a social distance of six (6) feet, washing and sanitizing hands, seeking medical attention if symptoms appear, etc.
- D) Will continue to monitor the situation and make further decisions with guidance and information provided by the Livingston Parish Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness (LOHSEP), the Louisiana Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness (GOHSEP), the Louisiana Department of Health (LDH), the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and the United State Government.
