PROCLAMATION NO. 56 BJ 2011

MUNICIPALITY OF WALKER – CHANGE IN CLASSIFICATION

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Alderman of the Town of Walker has sent a Resolution requesting a change in classification of Walker from Town to a City, in accordance with R.S. 33:342(A);

WHEREAS, the Governor has investigated the facts in accordance with R.S. 33:342(B), through the U.S. Census Bureau 2010 Census Data; and

WHEREAS, those having more than five thousand inhabitants are cities as per R.S. 33:341; and

WHEREAS, such record shows that the municipality of Walker's certified census shows a population of 6,138 persons;

NOW THEREFORE, I, BOBBY JINDAL, Governor of the State of Louisiana, by virtue of the authority vested by the Constitution and the laws of the State of Louisiana, do hereby order and direct as follows:

SECTION 1: That the municipal classification of the Town of Walker shall be changed from a Town to a City in accordance with R.S. 33:341 and 33:342.
