

UNIFORM CRIME REPORT

CRIME STATS COMPARISON FOR YEARS 2012-2013

The City of Walker will be submitting the annual comparison chart of the Uniform Crime Report to the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement. The 2012-2013 report indicates a 12.47% overall decrease in crime when compared to statistics from 2011 – 2012. In addition, the report demonstrates a decrease in violent crime by 13.6% and property crime by 12.3%.

There were no reportable homicides, negligent homicides, or arson for 2013. One incidence of the rape was reported in 2013.

Additionally, the Walker Police Department's rate of arrests per offense increased by 32%:
